Delaware Trust bank was founded by the DuPont family. The corporate officers, some of whom were DuPont descendants, sought to continue the legacy of the family with a “Winterthur-inspired” office fit-out, including quality reproduction antique furniture, textiles and decor.

The scope of work included space planning, design of woodwork and architectural elements, design of custom office furniture true to the historic style, specification of antique reproduction furniture and textiles, furniture procurement and installation management. Where possible, quality stock components and fixtures were specified, and modified as required to fit the idiom and requirements of the architectural style. During construction, the designers worked closely with the craftsmen to ensure faithfulness to the style.
